Statement of the Chin National Council on the Current Political Unrest in Burma

1. Chin National Council (CNC) strongly backs up the ongoing peaceful demonstration of the people movement of students-youth, women and monks across the country including Hakha town of Chin State, in an effort to restore freedom from long suppressions of the military dictatorship regime and for alleviation of the rising prices and oppressions in Burma. Chin National Council strongly supports the people's demand and stoutly opposes the SPDC's violent response to the people at large.
2. The SPDC by taking the people movement as a chance to claim on distorting the country's security, has used its hired anti-people group to bump up the peaceful people movement in attempting to turn it into an anarchist stage. Therefore, CNC would like to urge students-youth, monks and the people to be cautious to pilot the movement in a disciplined approach and with courage so that the peaceful people movement should not adversely turn to anarchist stage.
3. Chin National Council is in full solidarity with the statement of monks released on September 15, 2007 which calls for the participation of students-youth and all classes of people of Burma in the set struggle for changes. Coincidentally, the Council would like to encourage;
 - All the Chins people across the world should have backed up the people movement in Burma by staging demonstration in their respective countries
 - All the Chin people abroad and inside should have held a prayer service for the people movement in Burma
 - Chin people in Burma should have steadfastly participated in the ongoing people movement
4. Chin National Council warmly welcomes Mr. Tang Jia Xuan, a veteran diplomat of the Chinese government urged of the military junta to speech up rendering state's tranquility and to promote the national reconciliation process in a more tangible way and his hope for the nation heading toward a decent democracy soon. Similarly, CNC would like to request the United Nations and neighboring countries such as India, Bangladesh, ASEAN to support for transforming Burma from dictatorship rule to a Federal Democratic Union of Burma.
5. As the root cause of Burma problem is due to political crisis, the ongoing political dilemma itself is due to deficiency of democracy and SPDC's failing system of governance over the country, Chin National Council earnestly request SPDC, not to suppress the people by means of weapon, but to solve out the political crisis by means of political solution.
