Chin National Community-Japan(CNC-Japan) Condemn the Execution of Three Village Headmen by Burmese Army

Chin National Community - Japan (CNC-Japan) condemn the executions of three village headmen, namely Hung Ling (25) of Cun-Nam village, Maung Khe (32) of Lung-Phunu Village and Ting Co of Sangseh village, in southern Chin State by troops from Burma Army Light Infantry Battalion (LIB) 104 and LIB 304 under Tactical Operation Command II based in Matupi headed by Colonel San Aung.

CNC-Japan extends our deepest sympathy and condolence to the murdered victims' families of Cun-Nam village headman Hung Ling (25), Lung Phunu Village headman Maung Khe (32) and of Sangseh village headman Ting Co. CNC-Japan also concern for the missing two villagers, Khin Maung Oo and Tin Ceu of Sangseh village.

The Burma army uses the presence of CNF/A as an excuse for killing, raping and torturing innocent Chin civilians. Many innocent Chin people are accused of sympathizing or supporting financial assistance directly or indirectly to CNF/A without enough proofs and evidences. Whenever the skirmish fight between the Burmese army and CNA occurs, and it results the casualties from Burmese army, the Burmese army in return persecutes, rapes and executes the innocent Chin civilians.

“It is a norm rather than exceptional practice within the Burma Army to summarily execute anyone suspected of being anti-regime. Too many cases of summary executions have been carried out with impunity against ethnic community across Burma. This kind of arbitrary killing is meant to teach a lesson to the public that the price of the dissident is death” said Salai Bawi Lian Mang, director of Chin Human Rights Organization in CHRO press release.

CNC-Japan urge the State Peace and Development Council to immediately case such kinds of practices and executions of innocent civilians without judicial trial and to investigate the summary killing of the three headmen.

And we, CNC-Japan whole-heartedly endorse and welcome Chin Human Rights Organization call for the UN special Rapporteur on Extrajudicial, Summary or Arbitrary Executions to conduct an independent investigation into extrajudicial and summary killings of civilians in Burma.
